

Episcopal Consecrations conferred by Archbishop Ngn Dhin Thuc, or by any Catholic Bishop consecrated prior to the new rite of Episcopal Consecration (1968).

Beginning of an Episcopal lineage.

Link of Episcopal Consecration. From the Consecrating bishop, to the consecrated.

Link of Episcopal Co-consecration. From the Co-consecrating bishop, to the consecrated.

Link of Presbyteral Ordination. From the Ordaining bishop, to the ordained priest.

Claim to Ordinary Jurisdiction. Some Bishops have claimed ordinary jurisdiction upon certain regions of United States or Europe.

Claim to Papacy. Alleged Papal powers received either by election or mystical phenomena.

In Blue, Ordination to deaconate or sub-deaconate.
In Orange, Ordination to any minor order or clerical tonsure. It would be too arduous to relate every order in every particular case, and would make the Map unclear. Therefore, we choosed to trace links when we have judged it useful to reveal past or present eccontations.

Non-Exhaustive Map of Episcopal Consecrations deriving from Thuc lineage

Robert Biarnesen (Names colourred in brown designate members of any sort of schismatic or heretical sect (Old Catholics, Jansenists, National Churchists...), and considered as such before 1962.)

ANTE (Dotted links designate doublet Episcopal or Presbyteral Ordinations, in so far as validity of the Sacrament conferred is concerned.)

ARCH. (Presbyteral ordination conferred by Archbishop Marcel Lefebvre.)

? (No prove of Presbyteral or Episcopal Ordination.)

? (Alleged Presbyteral or Episcopal Ordination, without any prove nor claim from those concerned, merely kept going by public rumour.)

? (Alleged apparitions or visions, or more generally false mysticism.)

? (Recognized exoterism, occult practices, or proven affiliation to Free-Masonry.)

? (Forged documents of ordination, or pretended ordination.)
